
Annual Safety Goals 2020-2021

The MetroED Safety Committee identifies safety-related goals for the next school year and discusses the strategies and/or programs that will be used during the year to meet those goals. The objective is to provide meaningful goals in order to improve the campus climate.

The goals are reported, with the Safety Plan, to the MetroED Governing Board and are shared with the school staff and community.

Safety Plan Goals

Based on the school safety assessment items discussed at its September 2019 meeting, the MetroED Safety Committee agreed to continue placing the highest priorities on the following areas for protecting the safety of MetroED students, staff and facilities for the 2020-2021 school year:

1. Parking lot flow and safety: Buses cannot move/leave until all students are on.
2. Evacuation procedures: Train Division Leaders and backups assigned to evacuation areas
3. Lockdown procedures: Get “Run, Hide and Defend” training from SJPD; Incorporate into procedures
4. Medical Emergency procedures: Clarify who responds and action plans for injured
5. CPR/First Aid Training for employees
6. Safety Training Plan for all employees: Incorporate into hiring process
7. Infinite Campus and ASAP Programs for emergency communications

Other issues of concern include:

- A. Emergency Response Teams training: Set training date
- B. Communication Procedures: Work with Principals
- C. Triage training for employees: Include in CPR/First Aid Training
- D. Door Security: Work with Principals to reinforce Closed-Doors Policy
- E. Review classrooms and offices for emergency exit signage

Goals Assessment

Progress on annual safety plan goals is assessed each year at the Safety Committee’s last meeting in May.
