SVAE is a comprehensive adult school offering entry-level and advanced health, technology, and careers in the trades. We also provide FREE English as a Second Language (ESL), Adult Basic Education (ABE), High School Equivalency (HSE) preparation for GED and HiSET tests, and High School Diploma (HSD) subject courses both on-campus and online. SVAE is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

Silicon Valley Adult Education offers free assessment tests to enter ESL, ABE, HSE, and HSD courses, along with academic and career counseling. The Regional Testing Center, located at the Hillsdale main campus, offers state and national tests such as GED, HiSET, CBEST, CSET, CPACE, among many others, for the convenience of our students and community.

CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION COURSES

INTEGRATED EDUCATIONAL TRAINING

Integrated Education and Training (IET) refers to contextualized English as a Second Language (ESL) or Basic skills classes that prepare English Language Learners to succeed in a specific career technical class (CTE). Career Technical education classes are available for all students. IET classes are specialized ESL classes to help prepare language learners for eligibility to enroll in CTE courses. ESL students in Intermediate High and Advanced levels are eligible.

AUTOMOTIVE

Auto Body Repair

Introduction to auto body repair covers current industry standards on vehicle construction, metal straightening techniques, body fillers, MIG welding, removal and replacement of bolted and welded auto parts. In addition, shop safety practices will be covered.

HEALTH SCIENCE & MEDICAL



Medical Assistant Back Office

Assist physicians in the back office or clinic, medical lab, and EKG training. A 120-160-hours clinical assignment at a different site by arrangement is required.

Prerequisite: High School reading level and passing Medical Terminology with a "C" or better. A physical exam and shots (TB, Tdap, Flu, Titer) are required by the fifth week of class. All students will take the CASAS basic assessment before they are registered in a class.

Medical Assistant

This medical assistant course is a oneyear program consisting of eight modules and a month of externship. Each module meets daily for five to six weeks. At the end of the course, students will demonstrate mastery in front and back medical office procedures. Students may begin the program at the start of any module, as space is available.

Prerequisite: TB test results, proof of current immunizations, complete physical exam. All students will take the CASAS basic assessment before they are registered in a class.

Medical Terminology


Learn and recognize word roots, prefixes, and suffixes used in medical language. Learn how to combine words to create meaningful medical conditions, comprehend their definition, and know the correct spelling. Emphasis is on medical terminology, anatomy and physiology, communication, medical ethics, and legality. This class meets the prerequisites for the Medical Assistant Back Office class.

MANUFACTURING

Welding, All Levels

Instruction includes Oxyacetylene, Flux-cored Arc Welding (FCAW), Shielded Metal Arc (SMAW), Metal Inert Gas (MIG), and Tungsten Inert Gas (TIG). Students furnish personal equipment and some consumable items. This is a certificate course and one that is in high demand in the Bay Area.



ADULT BASIC EDUCATION (ABE)

Adult Basic Education (ABE) classes build skills for the workplace and review basic skills in reading, writing, and math. The purpose of the class is to raise the levels of competency so students can be promoted to the High School Equivalency (HSE) Preparation or the High School Diploma (HSD) programs. In ABE, students may earn elective credits transferable to the High School Diploma program.

- You must change or cancel an appointment at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled exam date
